

Parties Involved: Acme, Inc. (ACME-1) and the Sperm Donor, outlining responsibilities and expectations.

Purpose of Donation: To facilitate artificial insemination exclusively for Acme, Inc.

Expectations:

- Donor: Provides sperm samples.
- Acme, Inc.: Uses sperm for insemination and adheres to confidentiality.

Medical and Health Criteria:

- Required Testing: Genetic screening and infectious disease testing.
- Health Standards: Donor must be free from genetic disorders and infectious diseases.
- Consent: Documented via signed consent forms.

Confidentiality:

- Donor identity and recipient information are protected.
- Limits: Disclosure as required by law.

Parental Rights and Liabilities:

- Donor relinquishes all parental rights and responsibilities.
- · Donor is not liable for child support.

Compensation and Expenses:
