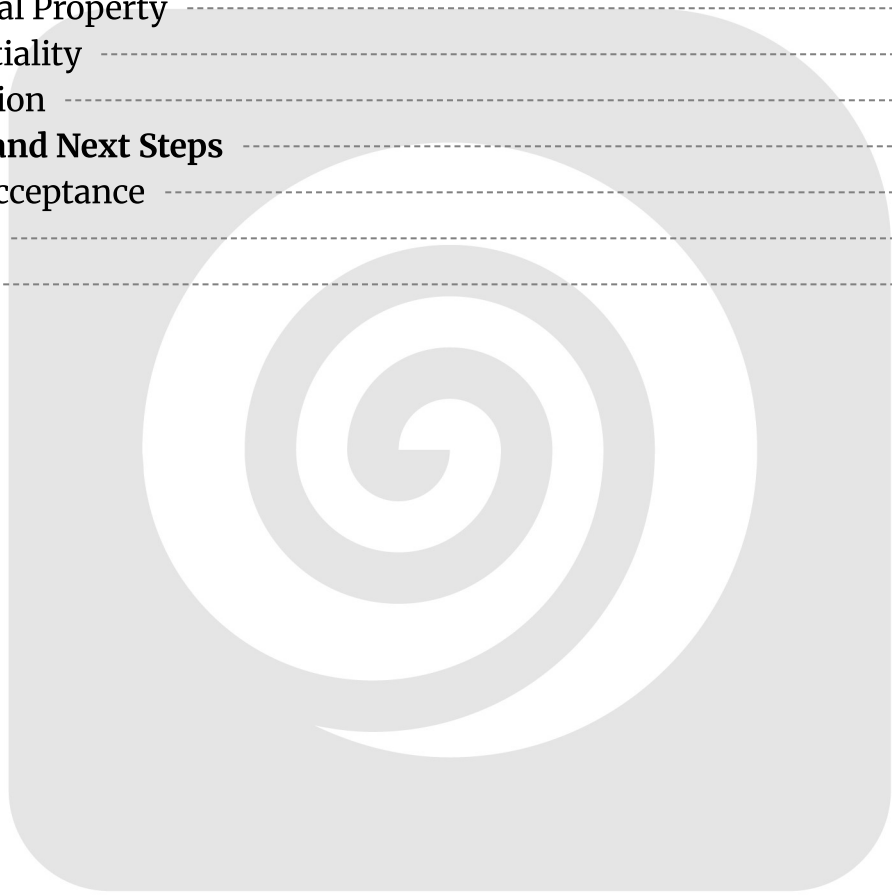


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Introduction

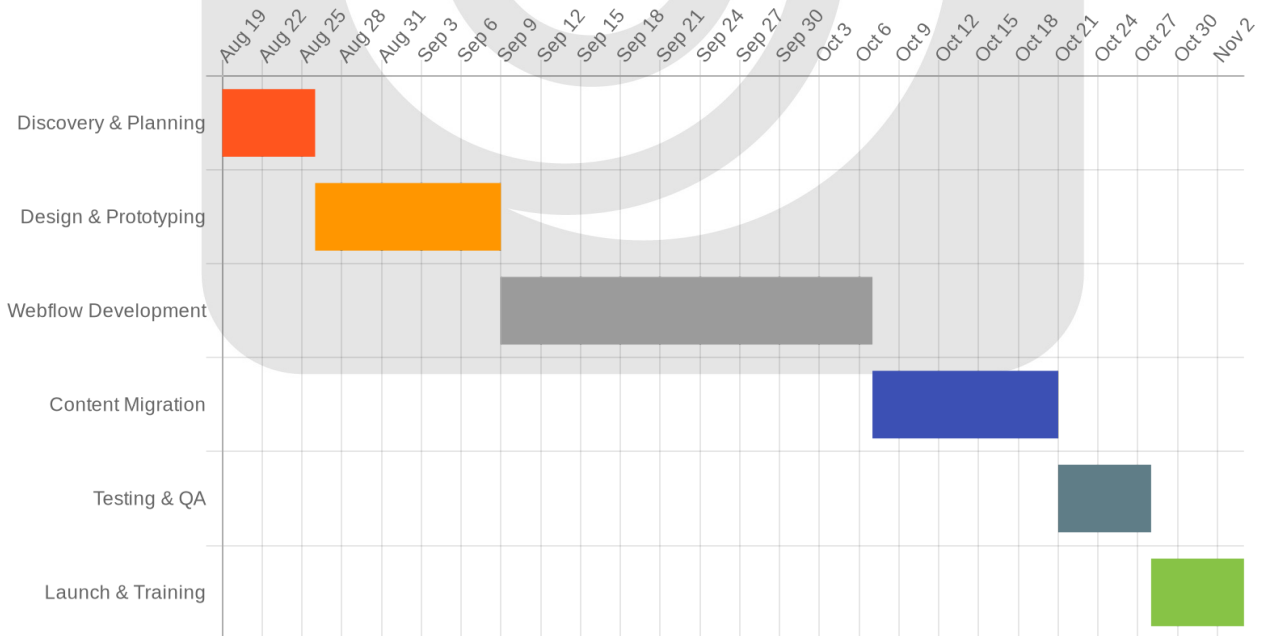
6. Launch & Training (Estimated Duration: 1 week)
